

# Antje Graf (DZB, Leipzig/Germany) „Inclusive OCW“: Inclusive and Collaborative Creation and Use of OpenCourseWare for Vocational Promotion for Visually Impaired People.

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The project InclusiveOCW aims at providing an accessible platform for study materials based on the idea of Wikipedia. The platform should enable people to create, share, revise and reuse multilingual contents for teaching and learning. In order to achieve this, the learning platform slide wiki (slidewiki.org), which was created in a project nine years ago, will be expanded and enhanced in its practicality. DZB's main task will be to examine the accessibility of the platform and its contents according to BITV and WCAG. Furthermore, DZB will develop a concept which enables blind users to access copyright protected contents.

## **Vita**

The project is run by the the Berufsförderungswerk Halle/Saale in cooperation with different partners (Technische Informationsbibliothek, Forschungszentrum L3S, Leibniz University of Hannover, Fraunhofer IAIS, DZB).

Until 2008, Antje Graf studied publishing at HTWK Leipzig. Her final thesis discussed "Reading in old age – demographic change and its challenges for publishing houses". From 2007 on, Antje worked as projectmanager in the field of electronic media and production of magazines. Since April 2018, she has participated in the project Inclusive OCW and supported the aspects of Accessibility and Usability for blind and visually impaired people.
